Exercise 1: Gap-Fill (Using the Correct Form of Past Continuous)

Instructions: Complete the sentences using the correct Past Continuous form of the verb in brackets.

Key Focus:

- Past Continuous structure: was/were + verb-ing
- Time markers: while, when, at that time, at 8 p.m.
- Question structure: Was/Were + subject + verb-ing?



Exercise 2: Error Correction (Fixing Mistakes in Past Continuous Sentences)

Instructions: Each sentence below contains a mistake with **Past Continuous**. Identify and correct the errors.

1.	×	They was playing football when it started to rain.
2.	×	She weren't listening to the teacher.
3.	×	While I talked on the phone, my brother was shouting.
4.		He didn't watching TV when you called.
5.	×	We was not sleeping when the baby cried.

* Key Focus:

- Use "was" with singular subjects & "were" with plural subjects (I was, you were, he/she/it was, we/they were).
- Past Continuous requires "was/were + verb-ing" (She was watching, not "She watching" or "She watched" in this context).
- Use "while" for ongoing actions, "when" for interruptions (While I was talking, my brother was shouting).
