

Used to and Would - Past Habits - Worksheet 1 - ANSWERS

Exercise 1: Sentence Matching – Used to vs. Would (Answers)

A: Sentence Beginning	B: Sentence Ending
1. When I was a child, I used to/would	h) spend hours talking on the phone. (Both "used to" and "would" work because it's a repeated action.)
2. My grandparents used to	d) have long hair, but now he's bald. (Only "used to" works because "have" is a state, not an action.)
3. We would	g) always visit us during the holidays. ("Would" works because it's a repeated action.)
4. He used to	b) live in a small village before moving to the city. (Only "used to" works because "live" is a state, not an action.)
5. She used to/would	a) always wake up early on Saturdays. (Both work for a habitual action.)
6. I never used to	f) enjoy eating vegetables, but now I do. (Only "used to" works because "enjoy" is a state.)
7. They would	c) play football in the park every weekend. ("Would" works because it refers to a repeated action.)
8. My best friend and I used to/would	e) tell us bedtime stories when we were little. (Both work for a repeated action.)

Exercise 2: Error Correction – Used to & Would (Answers)

- 1. When I was younger, I used to play outside every evening. \checkmark (Corrects "was used to play" \rightarrow "used to play")
- 2. My grandfather **used to live** in a big house before he moved to the city. **✓** (Corrects "would live" → "used to live" because "live" is a state.)
- 3. She didn't use to like coffee, but now she drinks it every day. ✓ (Corrects "didn't used to" → "didn't use to.")
- 4. We used to go camping every summer, but now we prefer hotels. (Correct as is!)
- 5. I used to have a dog when I was a child. ✓ (Corrects "would have" → "used to have" because "have" is a state.)
- 6. He didn't use to watch TV, but now he does all the time. (Correct as is!)
- 7. I used to go swimming every weekend, and I still do. X (Incorrect use of "used to"—if the habit continues, simple present is better: "I go swimming every weekend.")
- 8. They would be very shy when they met new people, but now they're confident. (Correct as is! "Would" works for repeated past behaviour.)
