

## Relative Pronouns and Clauses – Exercise Sheet 1 - ANSWERS

### Exercise 1: Fill in the Gaps (Relative Pronouns & Adverbs) - ANSWERS

1. The boy **who** won the race is my cousin.  
→ "Who" refers to a person (subject).
  2. This is the house **where** I was born.  
→ "Where" replaces "the house in which."
  3. Do you know the woman **whose** car was stolen?  
→ "Whose" indicates possession.
  4. I need to find the person **whom** I spoke to earlier.  
→ "Whom" is correct as it is the object (though "who" is often used informally).
  5. 2015 was the year **when** we met.  
→ "When" replaces "the year in which."
  6. The book **which** you recommended was excellent.  
→ "Which" refers to an object (the book).
  7. The company **where** I work is closing soon.  
→ "Where" replaces "the company in which."
  8. That's the reason **why** I quit my job.  
→ "Why" replaces "the reason for which."
  9. The teacher **who** helped me the most was Mr. Brown.  
→ "Who" refers to a person (subject).
  10. He is the actor **whom** I saw in a movie last week.  
→ "Whom" is correct as it is the object (though "who" is commonly used).
