## **Exercise 1: Fill in the Gaps (Relative Pronouns & Adverbs) - ANSWERS**

- 1. The boy who won the race is my cousin.
  - → "Who" refers to a person (subject).
- 2. This is the house where I was born.
  - → "Where" replaces "the house in which."
- 3. Do you know the woman whose car was stolen?
  - → "Whose" indicates possession.
- 4. I need to find the person whom I spoke to earlier.
  - → "Whom" is correct as it is the object (though "who" is often used informally).
- 5. 2015 was the year when we met.
  - → "When" replaces "the year in which."
- 6. The book which you recommended was excellent.
  - → "Which" refers to an object (the book).
- 7. The company where I work is closing soon.
  - → "Where" replaces "the company in which."
- 8. That's the reason why I quit my job.
  - → "Why" replaces "the reason for which."
- 9. The teacher who helped me the most was Mr. Brown.
  - → "Who" refers to a person (subject).
- 10. He is the actor whom I saw in a movie last week.
  - → "Whom" is correct as it is the object (though "who" is commonly used).
