

## Past Perfect Worksheet 1 - ANSWERS

### Exercise 1: Cloze Sentences – Past Perfect (Answers)

1. By the time we arrived at the station, the train **had left**. ✓ (Past Perfect shows the train left before we arrived.)
  2. She was upset because she **had failed** her driving test twice before. ✓ (Past Perfect shows failure happened before the moment she was upset.)
  3. When I got home, I realized I **had forgotten** my keys. ✓ (Past Perfect shows forgetting happened before getting home.)
  4. He didn't pass the test because he **had not studied** enough. ✓ (Lack of studying happened before failing the test.)
  5. We were tired because we **had walked** for hours. ✓ (Walking happened before feeling tired.)
  6. They were shocked to hear that the company **had closed** suddenly. ✓ (Closing happened before they found out.)
  7. Before she moved to Paris, she **had lived** in London for five years. ✓ (Living in London was before moving to Paris.)
  8. I **had never seen** such a beautiful sunset before that day. ✓ (The seeing event happened before "that day.")
  9. After he **had finished** his work, he went out for dinner. ✓ (Finishing work happened before going to dinner.)
  10. She couldn't believe he **had not told** her the truth earlier. ✓ (Not telling happened before she found out.)

### Exercise 2: Error Correction – Past Perfect (Answers in Bold)

1. When I arrived at the party, Sarah **had left** already. ✓ (Past Perfect needed because Sarah left before arrival.)
2. He was nervous because he **had not prepared** for the interview. ✓ (Past Perfect needed to show preparation was missing before the interview.)
3. We couldn't enter the stadium because we **had forgotten** our tickets. ✓ (Forgetting happened before attempting to enter.)
4. After she **had eaten**, she **went** to bed. ✓ (Past Perfect only for first action; "went" remains in Past Simple.)
5. He didn't want to watch the movie again because he **had seen** it last week. ✗ (Incorrect: "last week" suggests Past Simple: "He saw it last week.")
6. They were late because their car **had broken down**. ✓ (Breaking down happened before being late.)
7. She **had never travelled** abroad before she moved to Spain. ✓ (Never traveling happened before moving.)
8. I **had known** him for years before we became business partners. ✓ (Knowing happened before they became partners.)
9. When we got to the hotel, they **had lost** our reservation. ✓ (Losing happened before arrival.)
10. The police **had arrived** before the robbers **ran away**. ✓ (Arriving happened before running away.)
